Job Opportunity

Tsideldel First Nation is looking to fill a two-week contract for two Cultural Camp Coordinators to assist the Events Coordinator. The Cultural Camp Coordinators will be responsible for implementing cultural activities during Tsideldel's annual Cultural Camp. This position will be located at the Siwash Gathering.

The successful candidate will be responsible for arranging supplies, organizing cultural activities, food, events, and volunteers. The Tsideldel team will help through a committee and are seeking someone to lead the event and be the go-to person at the camp for the week of August 18 – August 26. The position will begin the week before the event to help plan and source supplies for the event.

The Cultural Camp Coordinators must possess the following skills and abilities:

- ability to deal with people sensitively, tactfully, and professionally at all times
- effective written and verbal communication
- considerable knowledge of Tsilhqot'in culture and traditions
- have a driver license and a clean criminal record
- organized and be able to work independently

We may consider a hybrid work arrangement for the planning week, but you will be required to be on site at the camp and supervise the event during the week of August 18 – 26, 2024.
